

Wilderness First Aid Basics

Our 2008 American Red Cross Wilderness First Aid Basics course is scheduled to be held **Friday, November 7 – November 9**. You must complete the entire course in order to be certified. This course is required for those participating in a Philmont Trek.

Wilderness First Aid Basics is an advanced first aid course designed to teach skills necessary for providing care to victims of illness or injury in a setting where professional help is delayed. This course goes beyond skills taught in basic first aid so participants are required to be proficient in those skills.

The course has been modified to meet the needs of Scouts and Scouters. It is scenario based and will be taught on the trail. Participants will carry a full pack just as they would for a high adventure trek. Meals will be provided to maximize teaching time.

Who can attend: Any Scout or Scout Leader with proficiency in first aid skills that are equivalent to First Aid Merit Badge.

When it is: November 7 – 9 we will begin at 7pm on Friday evening and conclude by 2pm on Sunday afternoon. All meals will be provided as part of the course fee.

What is the fee: **\$50.** This fee covers all materials for the course (books, reference cards, copies, etc.), food, BSA insurance, Red Cross certification fees, and the Red Cross WFAB Provider patch.

Where: Maumee Scout Reservation

Reservations Due: Reservations and payments are due no later than October 10 to the Hoosier Trails Council Service Center. No payments will be taken after that date or at the course check-in.
